





STEP #1


STEP #2

Set the two legs upright then lift the seat section and slide the castings into the slot shown on either end



STEP #3


Lift the rung bar into place and secure using the 1/2" bolt and washer configuration shown. Note: Only hand tighten at this stage.





STEP #4

Secure the lip of one casting to one end of the seat section using the 5/16" bolt configuration shown to the right. Repeat on the opposite end.



For step #4 use the bolt assembly shown below:



STEP #5

Carefully inspect the bench from front and back to ensure the legs of the bench are standing straight. Once everything is straight and aligned properly, tighten all bolts in the order the bench was assembled.
